Data collection by live interviewers from Princeton Survey Research Associates, Inc. This is a probability sample of 1000 American adults collected using an overlapping dual-frame design with 344 interviews collected by landline and 656 collected by cell phone. A two-stage weighting procedure was used on this dual frame sample.

UMass Lowell is a public institution and releases surveys as a source of public information. In this document, we have provided an extensive set of crosstabs.
