This agreement has been established between the University of Massachusetts Lowell, (UMASS Lowell) Manning School of Business and Great Bay Community College, Business Studies Department in order to facilitate the transfer process for student interested in pursuing a Bachelor's degree in Business.

Transfer students who complete the Associates Degree in Liberal Arts/Business Studies in accordance with the minimum standards as set by the Manning School of Business at the UMass Lowell, will be admitted to that department as juniors. Students who do not meet the aforementioned minimum standards will be a considered for admissions on a case-by-case basis.

OBJECTIVE:

- 1. To encourage the transfer of qualified students from Great Bay Community College to the UMass Lowell.**
- 2. To award academic credit for courses completed at Great Bay Community College the meet the terms of Liberal Arts/Business Studies Associates degree as stated in this agreement for application toward the requirements of the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration at UMASS Lowell.**
- 3. To provide effective and concise guidelines for students seeking to transfer to the University of Massachusetts Lowell. Students will have accurate and clear information regarding the transfer of their coursework and credits toward the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration.**

TERMS OF THE TRANSFER ARTICULATION AGREEMENT

- 1. UMASS Lowell guarantees the acceptance of students who have completed the Liberal Arts/Business Studies program at Great Bay Community College with an overall GPA of 2.2 or better entrance to the Bachelor of Science in Business Administration program.**
- 2. UMASS Lowell guarantees the transfer of credit as stipulated in the attached Program Guidelines. This agreement assumes the completion of the Associates Degree. UMASS Lowell may accept up to 68 credits towards the 120 required to complete the Bachelors' Degree.**
- 3. Great Bay Community College transfer students will be subject to all general education requirements of UMASS Lowell as set forth in the UMASS catalog.**

4. This document is based upon the evaluation of course descriptions presented to UMASS Lowell. Courses as listed in this agreement will transfer to UMASS Lowell provided a grade of C- or better has been earned.


5. Great Bay Community College students interested in participating in this agreement should be advised to take recommended courses suggested in the Program guidelines. The courses are required at UMASS Lowell and should be completed as part of the Associates Degree in Liberal Arts/Business Studies.

AGREEMENT DATES AND EXPIRATION:



Each institution will provide timely notice to the other in the event of any modification to the curriculum that might affect compatibility for admission and transfer of coursework. This agreement may be subject to change without notice, if curriculum requirements change at either institution. Students admitted to the Great Bay Community College's Liberal Arts/Business Studies Associate Degree program prior to such notification shall be admitted to the UMASS Lowell on the basis of this agreement.
