New iSiS My Advising Center

The University of Massachusetts Lowell has made enhancements to iSiS Student Self Service. You will notice a new 'My Advising Center' link in your iSiS Student Center. The new Advising Center brings together your important academic information into one central location to enhance the advising experience. From the 'My Advising Center' you will be able to:

- View your academic summary information by career and program
- View your courses by term as well as term statistics such as gpa and academic standing
- Access centralized registration links to search, plan and enroll for classes
- Add advising related notes to your account for your own personal use or to be shared with your advisor(s)
- Calculate your current Major GPA
- Access centralized degree requirement information

These changes are highlighted below.

My Advising Center Tab

You will see a new 'My Advising Center' tab in your iSiS Student Self Service.



Academic Summary

The 'Academic Summary' section allows you to view a summary of your career and program information. It also displays a summary of courses by term including term statistics.

General Info

The 'General Info' section allows you to view your service indicators, to do list as well as view and edit your addresses, email addresses and other personal information.
